**Suspected presence of Clostridium botulinum in Hipp's fruitmix for children
Banana and Peach**

The Danish National Food Agency, suspects that **Hipp's fruitmix for children
Banana and Peach article number 31330**, could contain the pathogen Clostridium botulinum. The product is sold by Arvid Nordquist.

The batch in question, batch number **L35655** and best before date **31/12/2008**, was delivered to customers in Scandinavia and Finland last year from July till September.

To our knowledge there has not been any suspicion or cases of food-poisoning concerning this, or any other batch in Scandinavia. The Danish National Food Agency has sent the product for analysis and results will be presented by the end of week 50.

Products that may be found in shops shall now be recalled. We also urge consumers not to eat the product but to throw it away instead. Any costs in connection with this complaint will be refunded by consumers sending the product label to Arvid Nordquist, address on the back of the product.
